Minutes from the August 1, 2007 Meeting

There was no July meeting. President, Pete Githens, called the August 1, 2007 meeting of the Reading Archery Club to order at 7:37 PM.

Treasurer's Report:

The treasurer report was read and circulated. Ending Balance for July was \$4417.12, with \$7628.86 in the savings. The taxes in the amount of \$2286.00 are due, as well as the web-site renewal. A motion to approve was made by Terry Templin and seconded by Mike Maoilie.

Committee Reports:

Building:

Pete will pick up the balast and 4 extra 8' lights before the next shoot.

We need to call Verizon to come out and fix the phone.

The indoor range need to be painted this fall.

Fuel Report – Penn Pride has 98 pre-paid gallons remaining. They offer this years pre-pay price at \$2.249 per gallon. Last year we used 300 gallons of cheaper fuel plus pre-paid 500 gallons. It has been decided to have 250 gallons delivered now to top it off, and then pre-pay 500 gallons for this winter.

Grounds:

The signs that Joe Kurtz made look great hanging up at the end of the driveway and at the corner of Church Street and 625.

We received a driveway quote from Ronny Folk Paving to excavate, grade and remove excess fill, from the parking lot. They would put down a 2" thick layer of 2A Modified Stone. 1548 square yards for \$4400.00 inclusive. Pete will call for a vote when he gets more information. Plastic and stone should be laid in the garage to help with moisture.

We really need a newer riding mower for next season.

Terry Templin and his father cleared the 3-D trails. Thank-you very much.

Indoor:

This winter the lanes for the field shoots need to be cleared. The bow holders need to be repaired or replaced and new markers made. We have requested that the JOAD members help to stencil the markers.
