Minutes from the July 2, 2008 Meeting

President, Pete Githens, called the July 2, 2008 meeting of the Reading Archery Club to order at 7:41PM.

Minutes from the June meeting were read and a motion to approve was made by Terry Templin and seconded by Chuck Trate.

Treasurer's Report:

The treasurer report was read and circulated. Ending Balances for June are \$2,672.37 in the checking and \$11,045.98 in the savings. A motion to approve was made by Chuck Trate and seconded by Terry Templin.

Membership:

No new members.

Committee Reports:

Building:

We have approximately ¼ of a tank of fuel oil remaining. Late winter we used less than 1,000 gallons of oil. It has been estimated that \$1300.00 would be needed to top the tanks off. The question has been posed, "should we split the cost with JOAD this year?" Everyone agreed that we should wait to call in the order.

Terry Templin has installed the new down spouting. He also spent some time cutting trails. Thank you.

Helen has the locksmith coming out to replace the master lock.

The battery in the door lock system needs to be changed.

The grids still need to be painted, so the tiles can be installed and the floor painted.

Fix the rotten spot in back left corner of the range floor.

Paint or Tape the new shooting lines.

Erect new exit signs and emergency lighting.

Install the molding around the range window.

Build a TV shelf in corner to the right of the range window in the social area.

The bars need to be installed over the kitchen window.

A drippy hot water valve should be repaired in the ladies room.

And, the bow press table needs to be installed or mounted.

Grounds:

Terry has located a craftsman mower for \$500.00. He will call tonight to see if it is still available.

The new targets have been placed, on skids, in position at the other end of the parking lot.

We need to level the shooting range.

Pour concrete pads for the new practice range, the shoot from.

The target butts need to be tied down.

Yardage markers need to be made.

The parking lot needs to be resurfaced.

Power wash the front of the building both siding and block wall.

After the power wash, paint the block, chimney and garage door.

The left side porch window needs to be capped.

Someone can build the tree stand behind the clubhouse.

And as always, firewood could be cut, split and stacked for this winter.

Indoor:

Pete's neighbor will be painting murals on the side range walls.

Pete made an electronic scoring machine. He also has a computer to run it. We will need to buy a 15" LCD screen, and cable to run half way down the range. The whole thing should cost about \$300.00.

A printer and laptop for the ranges use would be nice also.

3-D:

Last month we had eight guys help set up and 15 shooters.

The new tree stand, being built behind the club house, will be incorporated into the out door 3-D set up.

How difficult would it be for us to start night 3-D's in the old outdoor range area. We should be able to get the two light poles working again. We would need to run electric line down to the far pole.

The new 3-D targets are very nice. Come out and see them July 20th and August 17th during our outdoor season.

Activities:

We will be holding the gun raffle again this year.

Gary Wesner has spoken to Chuck about this years Outdoor Expo. Should we hold a shoot with a 16 target course? Chuck will be calling the promoter and getting more information. The Expo runs January 15th – 18th 2009.

Kitchen:

As soon as Helen finds a good deal, we will have a new griddle.

JOAD:

The shoot at Cacoosing Park was very hot. Only about 40 archers participated. Our JOADs did bring home some awards. Congratulations.

Web-Site:

It has been up dated by Pete.

Old Business:

The plaque for Julia hasn't been ordered yet.

Pete will talk to Julia about calling Camp Conrad Weiser.

Starting in 2009 we will be using yearly membership cards and a lock combination on the gate. If your yearly dues is not paid by February 1st, we will be adding a \$5.00 late charge.

New Business:

Should we raise the membership yearly dues to \$50.00 for an individual and \$65.00 for a family?

After the new outdoor range is finished, should we offer out door only memberships?
